Guidance for TTM Trainers, Attendees & Assessors for TTM Warrant Prerequisites

Warrant	Minimum prerequisite
TMO -NP Traffic Management Operative -Non-practising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TTM worker unit standard, or • TC or TC (I) warrant current or expired.
TMO Traffic Management Operative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current TMO -NP or • Current STMS (A/B/C) -NP.
STMS U Site Traffic Management Specialist Universal (this workshop will often be combined with training for one or more categories and result in an STMS –NP warrant)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TMO current or expired no more than 12 months, or • TMO -NP current or expired no more than 12 months, or • Current TC, or • Current TC (I).
STMS (A/B/C/M) -NP Site Traffic Management Specialist Category A, B, C, or Mobile -Non-practising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • STMS universal, or • STMS of any level current or expired or, • STMS of the relevant category current or expired.
STMS (A/B) -NP R Site Traffic Management Specialist Category A and/or B -Non-practising refresher	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • STMS of any level current or expired no more than 12 months; or • STMS of the relevant category (A for A refresher, B for B refresher) either current or expired no more than 12 months.
STMS (C) -NP R	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • STMS Cat C -NP current or expired no more than 12 months, or • L2/3 STMS -NP current or expired no more than 12 months.
STMS (ABC) -NP R Site Traffic Management Specialist Category C - Non-practising refresher	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • STMS (ABC) -NP current or expired no more than 12 months, or • L2/3 STMS -NP current or expired no more than 12 months.
STMS (A) Site Traffic Management Specialist Category A	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current STMS (A) -NP, and • TC or TMO current or expired no more than 12 months; or • STMS practising of any category current or expired; or • STMS of any level current or expired.
STMS (B) Site Traffic Management Specialist Category B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current STMS (B) -NP, and • TC or TMO current or expired no more than 12 months; or • STMS practising of any category current or expired; or • STMS of any level current or expired.
STMS (C) Site Traffic Management Specialist Category C	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current STMS (C) -NP, and • TC or TMO current or expired no more than 12 months; or • STMS practising of any category current or expired; or • STMS of any level current or expired.
STMS (M) Site Traffic Management Specialist Mobile	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current STMS (M) -NP and • TC or TMO current or expired no more than 12 months; or • STMS practising of any category current or expired; or • STMS of any level current or expired.

Inspector	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No prerequisite
TTM Planner - NP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Current STMS of any level, or Current STMS -NP for the categories of road you will be planning for, and Some experience with TMP forms.
TTM Planner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Current TTM Planner – NP, and Current STMS -NP for the categories of road you will be planning for.
TTM Mentor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Current STMS practising warrants for the categories of road you will be mentoring on, and Have not received an NNC within the preceding 12 months

Prerequisites for Trainer and Assessor Warrants

Warrant	Prerequisite
TMO (T)	Current TMO practising warrant, current STMS -NP warrant, registration with Connexis, working toward Certificate in Adult and Tertiary Teaching Level 4 or 5
STMS (T)	Experience as a TMO trainer for 12 months, current STMS practising warrant for the relevant category of road, registration with Connexis, Certificate in Adult and Tertiary Teaching Level 4 or 5
TTM Assessor	Current STMS practising warrant for the relevant categories of road you wish to assess on, registration with Connexis, NZ Certificate in TTM (Worksites) (when this is available)

Guidance for those with expiring CoPTTM warrants awarded prior to April 2021

Warrant	Where to next?
L1 TC - current	<p>Before your TC warrant expires you can either pass an STMS Universal workshop or refresh at a similar level to TC by passing a TMO -NP workshop.</p> <p>In order to practice on the road further training and assessment is required.</p>
L1 TC - expired	<p>You can regain a warrant at a similar level to TC by passing a TMO -NP workshop.</p> <p>In order to practice on the road as a TMO a TMO practical assessment is also required.</p>
L1 STMS – current or expired up to 12 months	<p>Pass an STMS refresher workshop to be refreshed as a non-practising STMS (AB) -NP.</p> <p>You can also pass the STMS (C) -NP workshop to gain the STMS (C) -NP warrant.</p> <p>In order to practice on the road as an STMS a practical assessment is also required for each category of road you will be working on.</p> <p>If your responsibilities fall solely into the role of STMS Mobile then you may prefer to pass an STMS Mobile -NP workshop and assessment instead.</p>
L1 STMS – expired more than 12 months	<p>Renew your STMS warrant by passing an STMS -NP workshop for each category of road you work on (Category A, B, C, or Mobile).</p> <p>It is recommended you first complete the STMS Universal workshop in order to receive training on critical components like prestart checks, crew briefings and worksite inductions which are not covered in the L1 STMS or Category -NP workshops. This may instead be covered when working with a Mentor to prepare for your practical assessment if preferred.</p> <p>In order to practice on the road as an STMS a practical assessment is required for each category of road you will be working on.</p>
L2/3 STMS or L2/3 STMS -NP current or expired up to 12 months	<p>Pass an STMS refresher workshop to be refreshed as a non-practising STMS (ABC) -NP.</p> <p>In order to practice on the road as an STMS a practical assessment is also required for each category of road you will be working on.</p>
L2/3 STMS or L2/3 STMS -NP expired more than 12 months	<p>Renew your STMS warrant by passing an STMS -NP workshop for each category of road you work on (Category A, B, C, or Mobile).</p> <p>In order to practice on the road as an STMS a practical assessment is also required for each category of road you will be working on.</p>
TC Inspector (TC (I))	<p>Pass an Inspector or TMO -NP workshop. The inspector warrant requires you to pass a practical assessment.</p> <p>In order to practice on the road as a TMO a practical assessment is required following the TMO -NP workshop.</p>

Certificate in Temporary Traffic Management (Worksites) Launching in October 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete micro-credential in Traffic Management Operative, and • Complete micro-credential in Site Traffic Management Specialist non-practising, then • Enrol in NZ Certificate in TTM(W) and complete US 31963 • or • For those who require Site Traffic Management Specialist Refresher training: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Complete 31962 – STMS -NP, and ○ Complete combined practical assessment with tasks from US 31958, US 31960, and US 31963.
